The story of RHYTHM AND BLUES

Rhythm and blues (R&B) was born in the 1940s. It was a combination of jazz and blues with a strong rhythm for dancing too. 1950s rock and roll has its origins in R&B, and R&B influenced soul in the 1960s and funk in the 1970s. Contemporary R&B has hip-hop and pop influences, and Mariah Carey, Destiny's Child and Usher are some of its biggest names.
